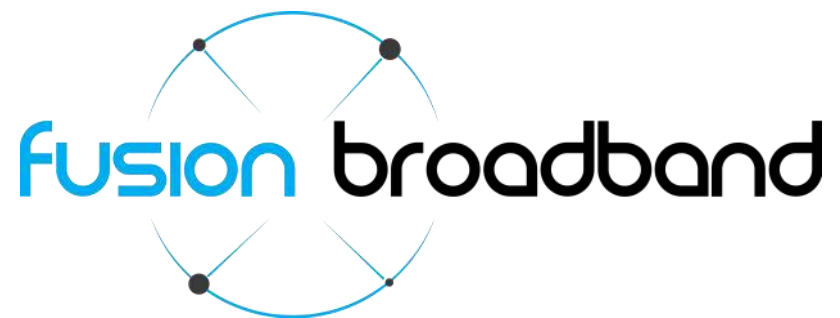

An Introduction to Fusion Broadband

Fusion broadband is a unique broadband bonding service - not an ISP. In short, Fusion Broadband simply fuses multiple broadband connections together to make a much faster and more reliable connection. The bonded connection combines the bandwidth capacity of each circuit connected in both uplink and downlink directions and presents itself to the network via a single cable and public IP or address range.

Who is Fusion Broadband?

Fusion broadband was established in 2009 through the need for faster broadband for small to medium businesses throughout Australia. We focus on providing broadband bonding solutions for most broadband technologies such as: ADSL, ADSL2+, its variants as well as SHDSL, BDSL, Ethernet and some wireless technologies.

Our goal is to provide businesses with an easy, affordable, broadband service that is ISP independent and provides customers ultimately what they need, high speed data connections with more reliability and stability. Our solutions can be provisioned as an add on service to existing broadband connections supplied through any ISP.
